

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
S.119 HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF CARDIFF (PUBLIC
FOOTPATH LISVANE NO. 14, CARDIFF) DIVERSION ORDER 2026

This Order is made by the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Applicant has agreed to contribute defray any costs which become payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Lisvane, Cardiff and shown by a continuous bold black line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after twenty eight days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. There shall at the end of twenty eight days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Lisvane, Cardiff described in part 2 of the Schedule to this order and shown by a bold broken black line on the map contained in this order.

SCHEDULE

Part 1 – Description of existing path or way

From Lisvane village the Public Footpath heads South along the accommodation road for 292m to Maerdy Farm (Point A; ST194827). The footpath crosses the frontage of the property (Point B; ST194827) and continues East through the farmyard and field gate. The path heads South (Point C; ST195827) across farm fields to the Nant Glandulais (Point E; ST197826).

Length of path to be stopped up: 397 metres Width of path: Undefined

Part 2 – Description of alternative path

From Lisvane village the Public Footpath heads South along the accommodation road for 292m to Maerdy Farm (Point A; ST194827). The footpath crosses Heol Nant Glandulas and onto a footpath to Clos Cae Coch (Point C; ST195827). Continuing along Clos Cae Coch for approximately 121m, the footpath heads South through an open space, crossing Rhodfa Pan Teg to link to the footbridge spanning Nant Glandulais (Point F; ST197826).

Length of path to be diverted: 432 metres Width of path: 2 metres

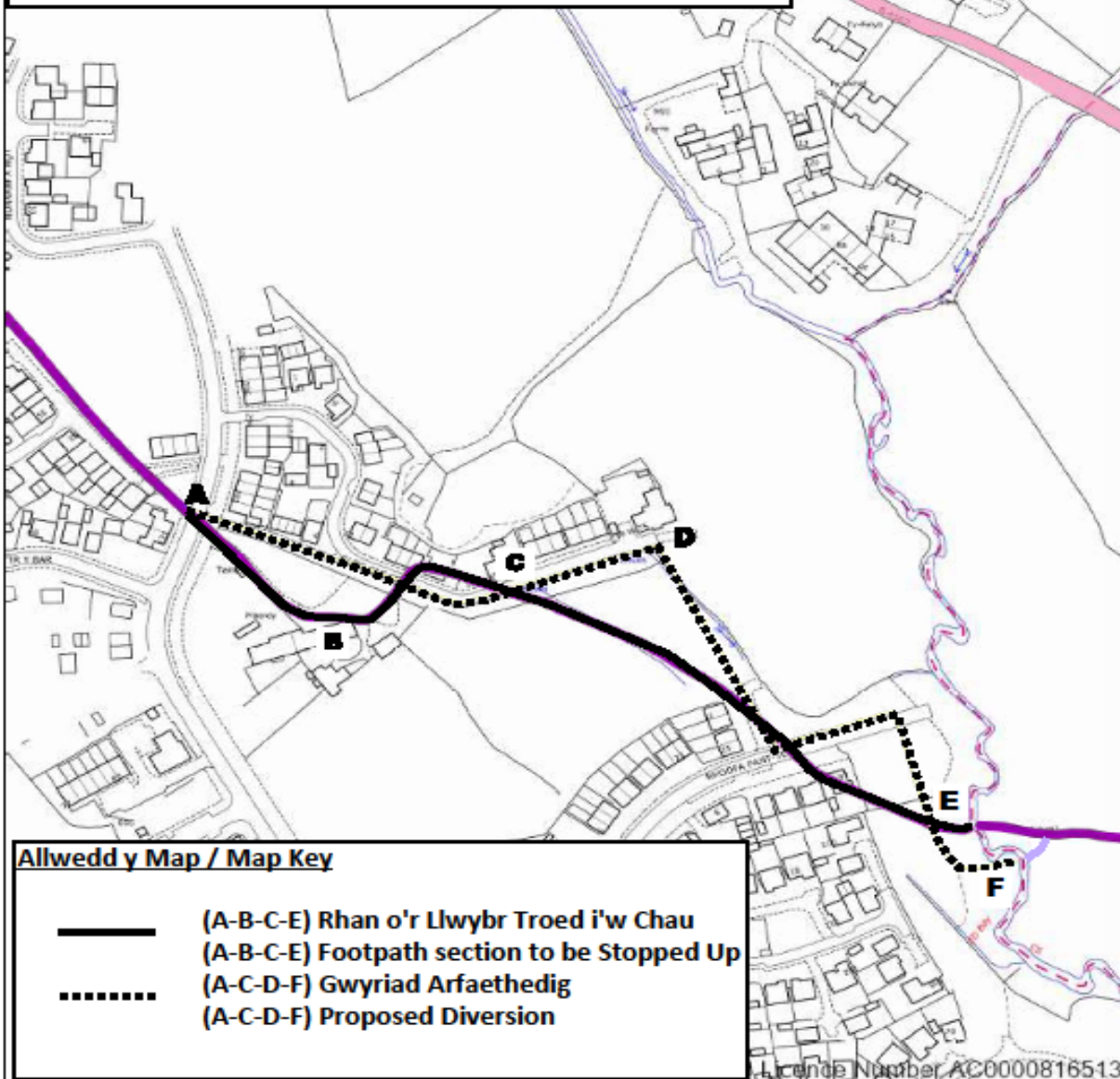
